

Never eat (or even touch!) any plant, berry, mushroom or anything else you find growing in the wild you cannot positively identify. **SOME WILD PLANTS AND MUSHROOMS IN THE UK ARE DEADLY POISONOUS.** You use the content in this map at your own risk!

Endangered or protected plants should never be collected. It is your responsibility to find out what these are.

It is illegal to dig up any kind of root growing anywhere in the UK without the landowner's permission; this includes uprooting anything you may be picking from.

It is illegal to pick wild food from anywhere in the UK to sell it unless you have the landowner's permission.

It is illegal to forage on any cultivated area such as farm land or orchards unless with the owner's permission.

Ask before you enter private land! Make sure you research the areas you go to thoroughly and read any available signs.

Avoid collecting diseased plants or ones with insect infestations. Avoid collecting from areas close to sources of pollution such as weed-killer spray, busy roads and dog poo!

Always leave a few healthy specimens and only take what you know you can use.

Use common sense and have respect for the plants and the area you are picking in!




