  - The spaces in the cottages are small with low ceilings and can get crowded. To avoid this, you can go through the quieter entrance near the café, please ask a member of staff.
  - There are exits on every floor if required – please ask a Visitor Assistant for help.

Narrow doorways

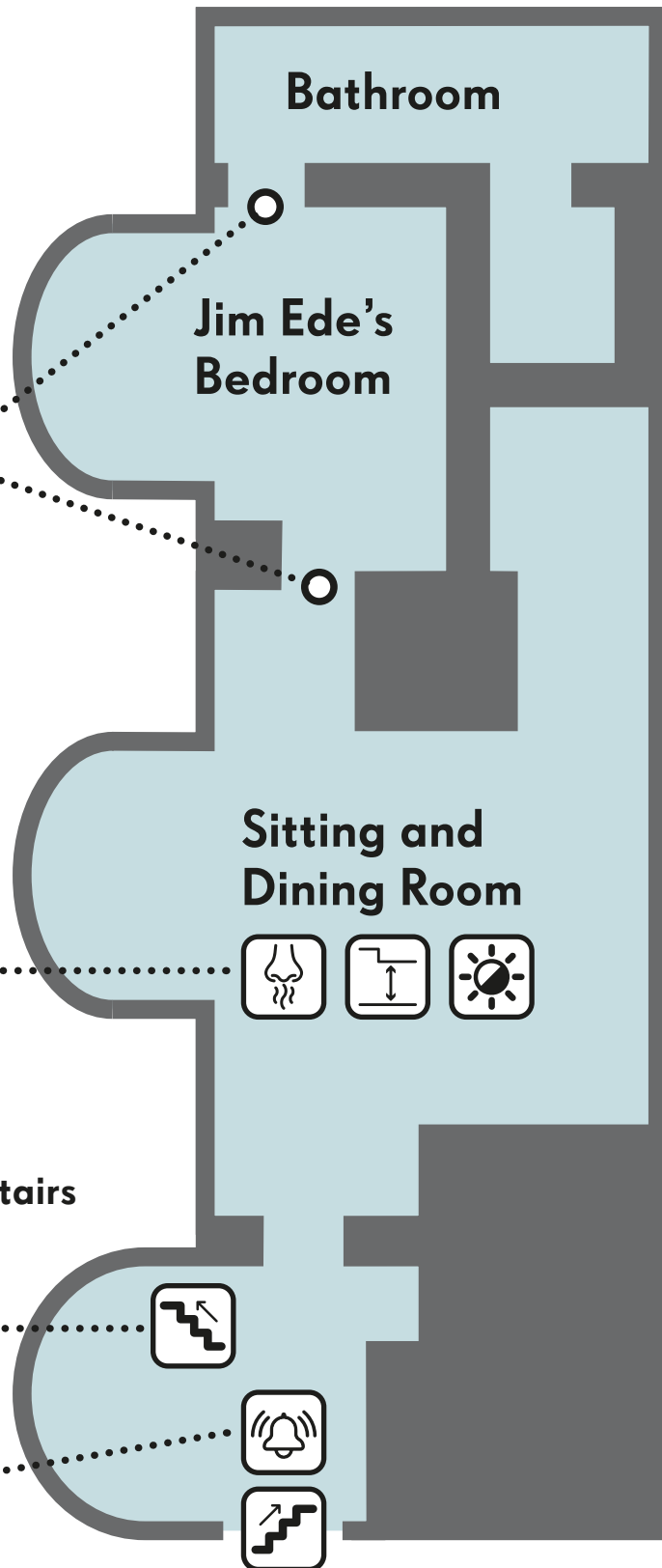

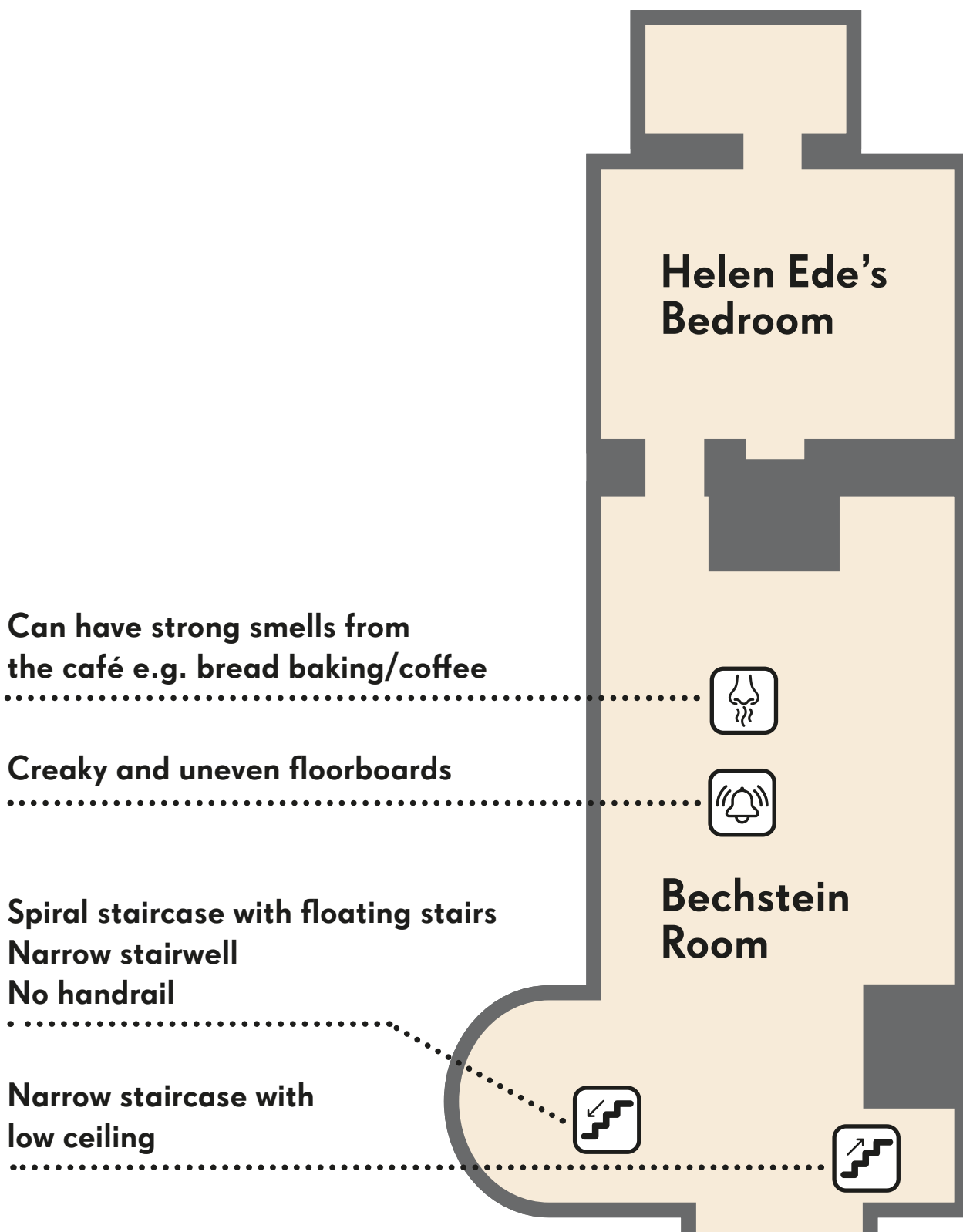

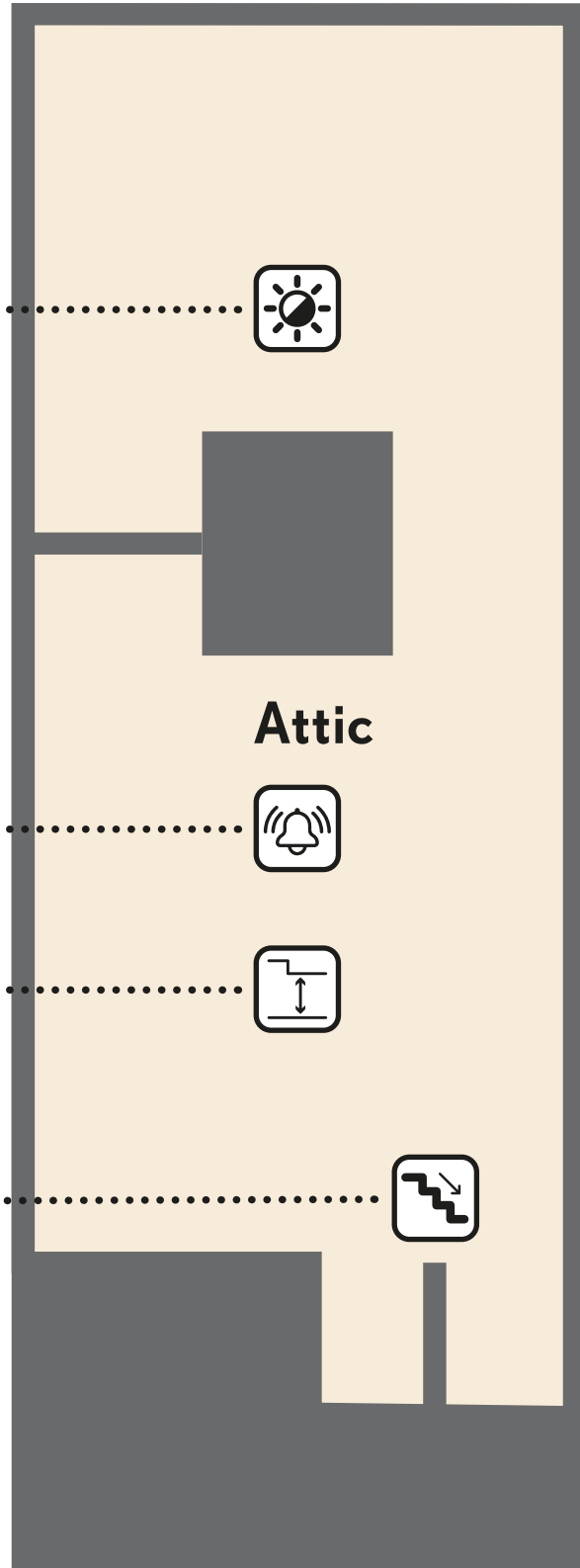

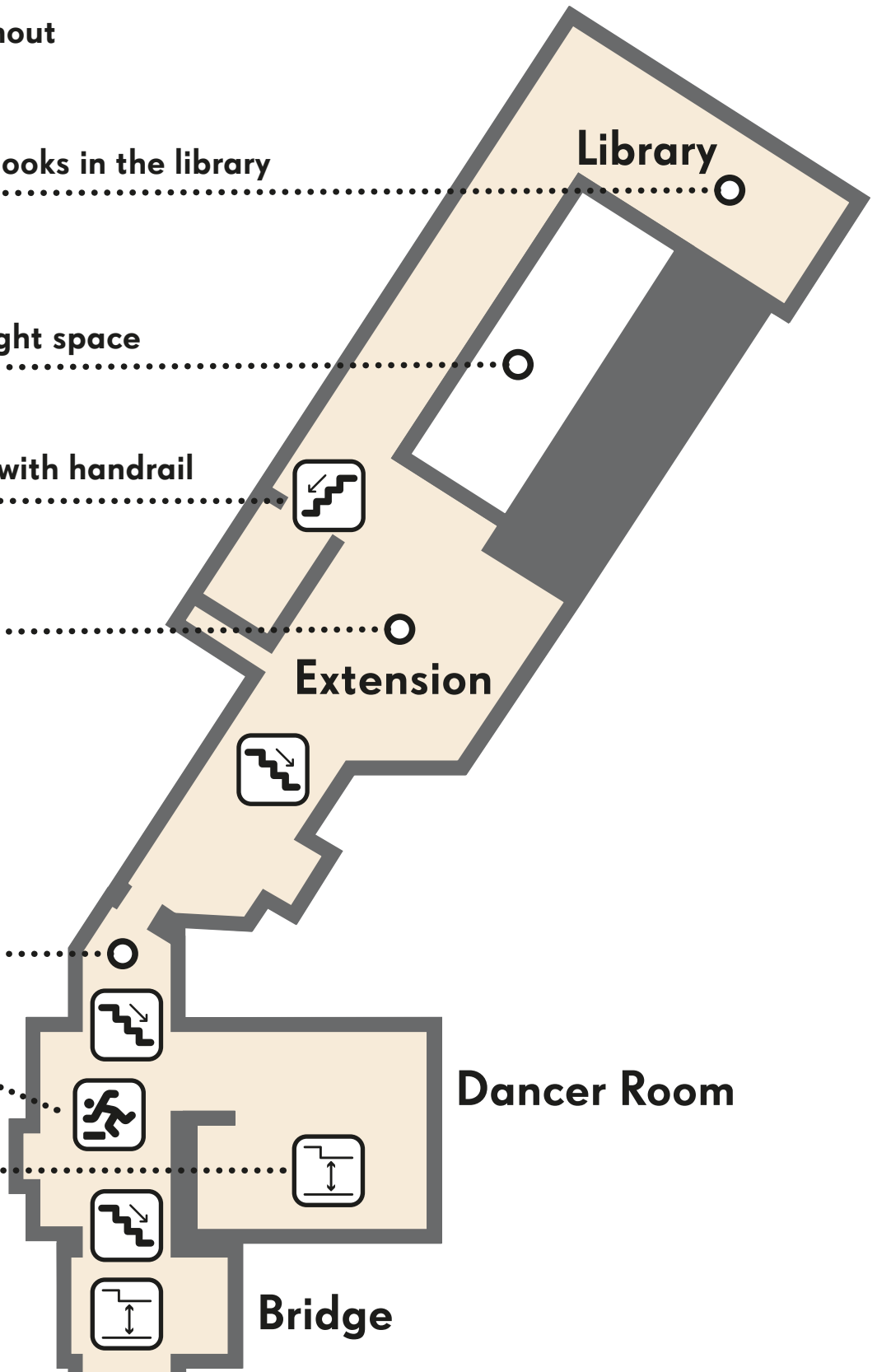

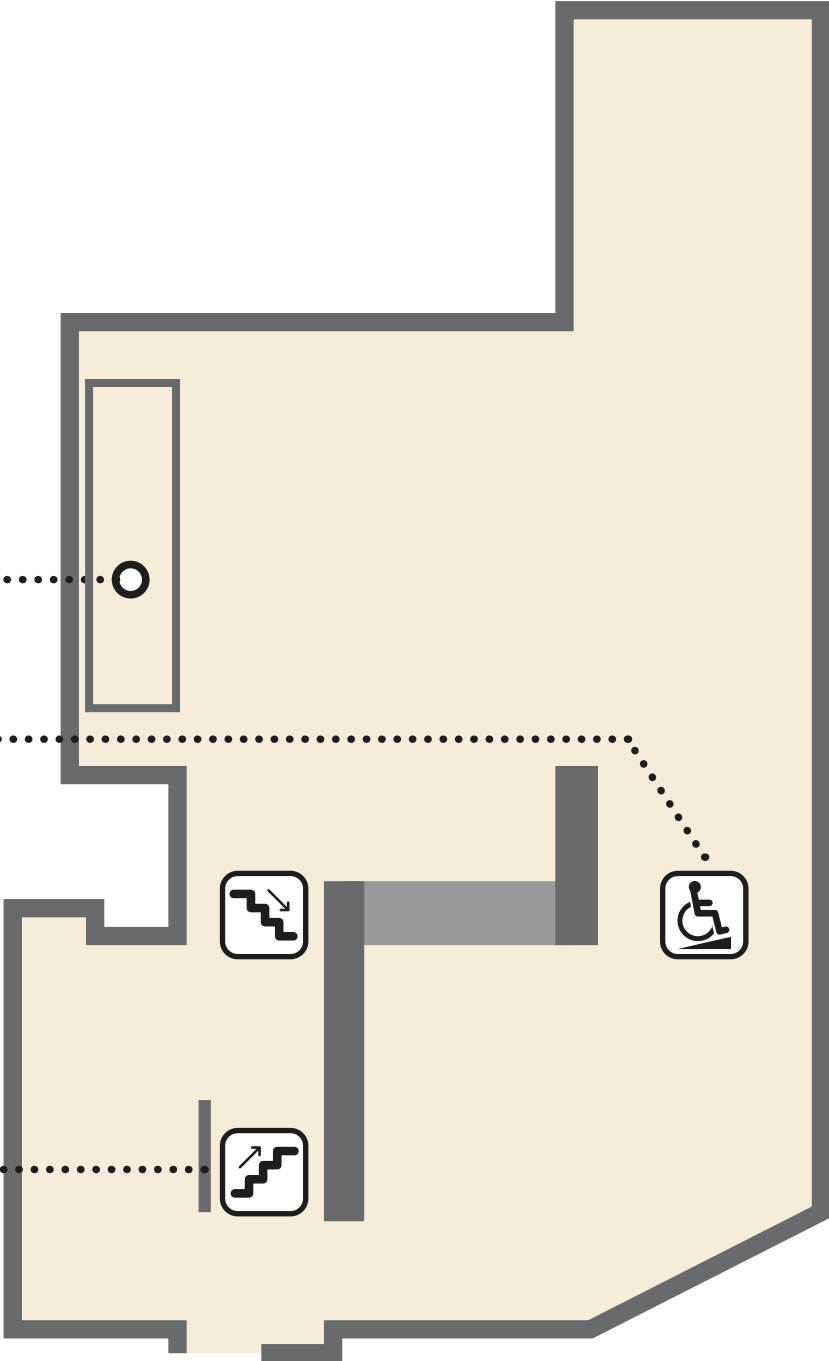

Can be crowded

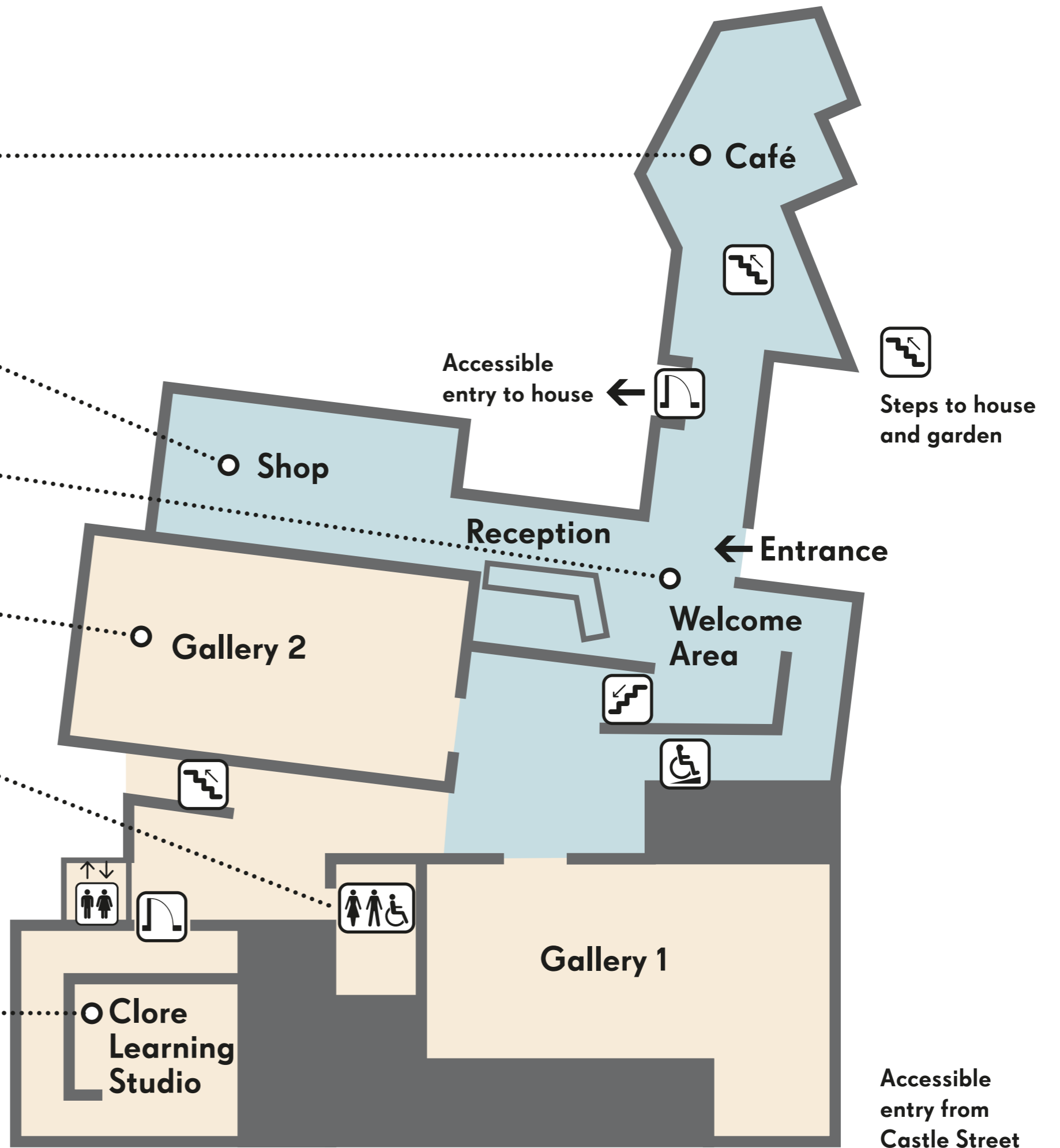

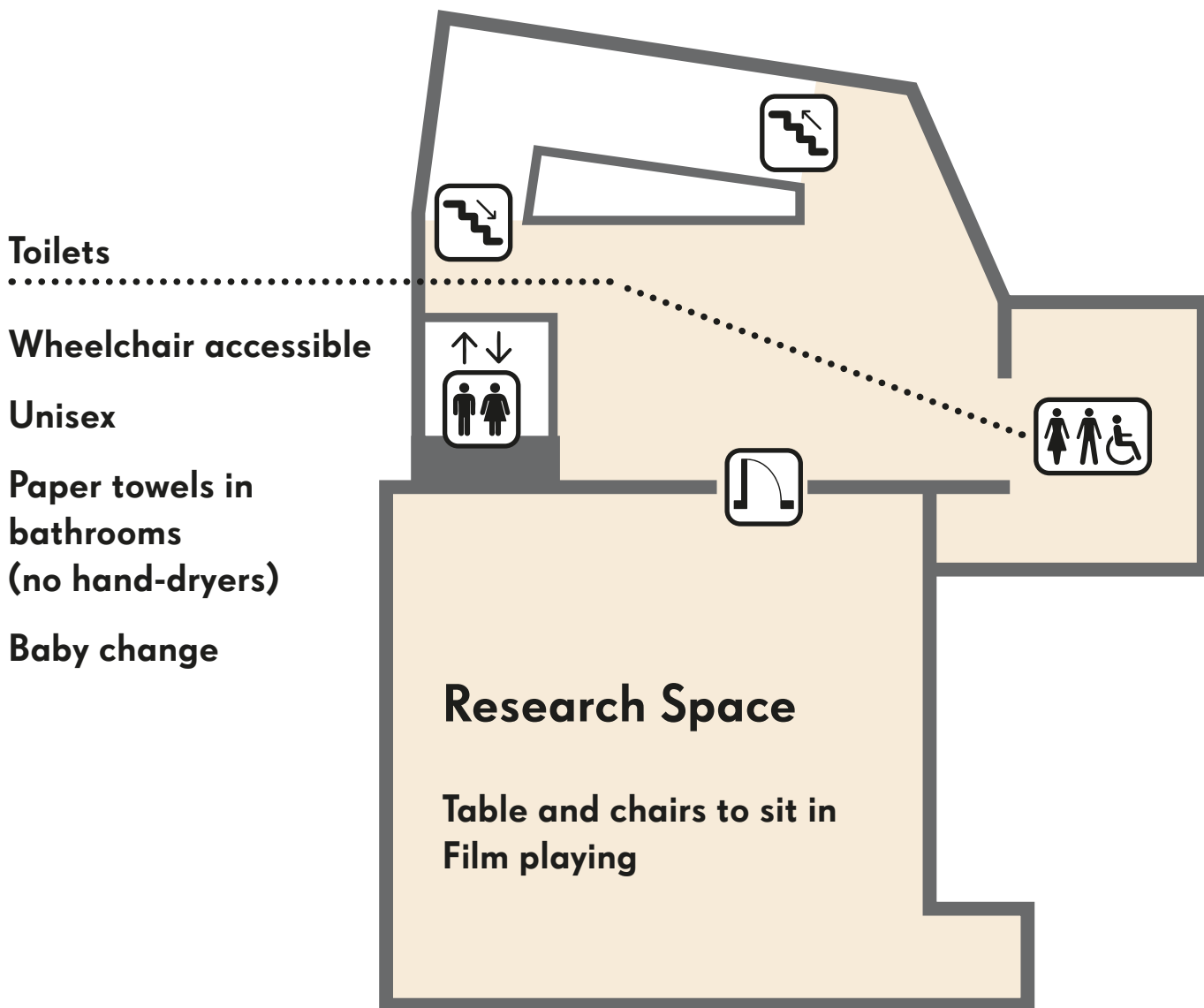
