
KETTLE'S YARD Music

We are looking for someone with a lively interest in chamber music to join the Kettle's Yard Music sub-committee in a voluntary advisory position. Music at Kettle's Yard comprises three series: Chamber Music, New Music and Student Music, each contributing a different dimension to the Kettle's Yard experience. These series have enjoyed great success and popularity over many years and continue both to please loyal audience members and to attract new visitors to Kettle's Yard.

In addition to its earned income, our music programme receives support from the University of Cambridge, a small number of trusts and from generous individual donors. The Music subcommittee is responsible for reviewing and approving proposed programmes of music here and for monitoring and receiving updates on the music budget. The sub-committee reports to the main Kettle's Yard Committee that oversees the governance of Kettle's Yard.

We are now seeking a new sub-committee member who can offer us their experience, expertise and connections to help us develop and secure the future of music at Kettle's Yard. The appointment is initially for two years and involves attendance at (usually) three meetings a year. Sub-committee members may also be asked to join a working group or attend occasional one-off meetings.

We believe that diversity strengthens and enriches us. We particularly encourage global majority candidates and people with disabilities to apply for this vacancy as they are currently underrepresented at Kettle's Yard. If you wish you can self-identify in your personal statement.
